RESOLUTION R93-35

A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, on Saturday, July 17, 1993, relative to term limitations for elected City officials.


BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Slidell, Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, does now proceed in open and public session to open the envelopes containing the official tabulation of votes cast at the election held in the City on July 17, 1993, to adopt certain amendments to the Home Rule Charter relative to term limitations for the office of Mayor, City Council Members, and Chief of Police; said tabulations having been prepared and certified by the election officials serving at the polls, and this City Council does now further proceed to examine, count and tabulate such votes and to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of said election.

SECTION 2. A Proces Verbal of the canvass of the returns of said election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office, another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, and another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of this City Council.

SECTION 3. The results of said election shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.
