RESOLUTION R93-41

A resolution requesting the State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) clean the W-14 and W-15 Lateral Canals in the Slidell area.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana DOTD cleaned the W-14 Canal from its intersection with Interstate 10 to Lake Pontchartrain, approximately ten (10) years ago; and

WHEREAS, said cleaning had a significant impact on rainwater runoff disbursements in the Slidell area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has experienced increased flooding and an inability to discharge rainwater runoff within the last two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, said rainwater runoff has begun to threaten many homes in the immediate area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request the Louisiana DOTD clean the W-14 Canal at it intersection with Interstate 10 to Lake Pontchartrain, and the W-15 Lateral Canal at its intersection with Interstate 10 to French Branch to provide assistance in the disposition and disposal of rainwater runoff.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this request be given immediate attention as a sense of urgency exists within the City of Slidell.
