9 A resolution requesting the Environmental Protection Agency to include the
10 hazardous waste pits at Southern Shipbuilding in the Superfund Cleanup Project.

12 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has Southern Shipbuilding located on the
13 banks of the Bayou Bonfouca; and


15 WHEREAS, said shipbuilder has had hazardous material identified in pits
16 on its property; and

19 WHEREAS, a superfund cleanup operation is presently underway on Bayou
20 Bonfouca in the City of Slidell, approximately one-half (1/2) mile from Southern
21 Shipbuilding; and

24 WHEREAS, the hazardous material at Southern Shipbuilding could be
25 transported by barge or truck to the new incinerator at the superfund site with little or no
26 disruption and at a minimal cost.

29 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does
30 hereby request the Environmental Protection Agency to include the hazardous waste
31 material at Southern Shipbuilding in Slidell, Louisiana, as part of the superfund cleanup
32 project, and in the alternative does hereby request that the incinerator at the superfund
33 cleanup site be used to assist with the disposal of the hazardous material in the pits of
34 Southern Shipbuilding in Slidell, Louisiana.
