RESOLUTION R93-47

A resolution appointing a Committee to review the Louisiana State Civil Service legislation, the City of Slidell Civil Service Rules, the City of Slidell Personnel Policy Manual and related matters.

WHEREAS, there are differences in the benefits afforded Police Civil Service employees and Municipal Civil Service employees; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Boards for each of these groups enact and recommend certain rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, a Personnel Policy Manual has never been formally adopted by the Slidell City Council; and


WHEREAS, the City's official external auditor, Deloitte & Touche has made certain recommendations regarding personnel matters.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby appoint a Committee to review the State legislation regarding the City of Slidell's Civil Service employment, rules adopted by the Police Municipal Civil Service Board and the Municipal Civil Service Board, and the existing employee Personnel Policy Manual.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Committee shall make recommendations to the Civil Service Boards, the Slidell City Council, and the Mayor regarding the jurisdiction for each of the herein stated bodies, and recommendations to comply with the 1993 Management Letter issued by the Audit firm of Deloitte & Touche.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that it is recommended that this Committee consist of the City Attorney, the City Finance Director, the Council Administrator, the Personnel Director, one employee of the Municipal Civil Service System, and one employee of the Police Civil Service System.
