**RESOLUTION R93-57**

A resolution certifying that the City of Slidell will assume full responsibility for the required local matching funds, and for managing and maintaining the Olde Towne Railroad Depot, as required under the requirements of the ISTEAs Enhancement Program and the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell was awarded a grant from the State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development, to renovate the Norfolk Southern Railroad Depot located on Front Street in Olde Towne Slidell; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is two hundred fifty-five thousand dollars (\$255,000.00); and


WHEREAS, the funding for this project requires that the local governing body provide matching funds in the amount of fifty-one thousand dollars (\$51,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the grant also requires that the local governing body assume responsibility for maintaining the property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby provide fifty-one thousand dollars (\$51,000.00) to be used as the required match with the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development for the renovation of the Olde Towne Railroad Depot.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Slidell assumes full responsibility for managing and maintaining the property as required by the ISTEAs and Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development.
