9 A resolution recognizing May 15 through May 21, 1994, as National Public
10 Works Week.

11 WHEREAS, public works services provided in our community are an integral
12 part of our citizens' everyday lives; and

13 WHEREAS, the support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital
14 to the efficient operation of public works systems and programs such as water, sewers,
15 streets and highways, public buildings, and solid waste collection; and

16 WHEREAS, the health, safety, and comfort of this community greatly
17 depends on these facilities and services; and

18 WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these facilities, as well as their
19 planning, design, and construction, is vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of public
20 works officials; and

21 WHEREAS, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff
22 public works departments is materially influenced by the people's attitude and
23 understanding of the importance of the work they perform.

24 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does
25 hereby recognize the week of May 15 through May 21, 1994, as "National Public Works
26 Week" in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and calls upon all citizens and civic organizations
27 to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in providing our public works and to
28 recognize the contributions which public works officials make every day to our health,
29 safety, comfort, and quality of life.
