9 A resolution asking the United States Congress to deed the Slidell NASA  
10 Computer Complex property to the City of Slidell.  
11

12 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell feels that the Greater Slidell Community could  
13 best be served by the City of Slidell having ownership of the NASA Computer Complex  
14 on Gause Boulevard within the City limits of the City of Slidell; and

15 WHEREAS, the elected officials of the City of Slidell are unified in their  
16 support for ownership of this facility; and

17 WHEREAS, at this time, the facility could best support our economy by  
18 utilizing it for education and health; and

19 WHEREAS, Representative Robert L. Livingston has proposed an  
20 amendment to a Congressional Bill which would deed the subject property to the City of  
21 Slidell; and

22 WHEREAS, a Congressional Act would simplify, expedite, and remove the  
23 red tape from the acquisition process; and


24 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council requests Senator J. Bennett Johnston,  
25 Jr., Senator John B. Breaux, Representative Robert L. Livingston, and Representative  
26 William Jefferson's support for Representative Livingston's Bill wherein the property would  
27 be deeded to the City of Slidell.

28 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it  
29 does call upon all Congressional Delegates to support the Congressional Bill which would  
30 deed the NASA Computer Complex facility on Gause Boulevard to the City of Slidell for  
31 its supervision and administration, with primary purpose and function for education and  
32 health.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council feels that the  
34 Greater Slidell area would best be served by the City of Slidell having ownership of said  
35 property.
