9 A resolution providing supplemental appropriations for Civil Service and  
10 Animal Control.

11 WHEREAS, several Council Members and members of the civil service  
12 boards met to review funding for various hearings and appeals before the municipal police  
13 and municipal civil service boards; and

14 WHEREAS, \$10,000.00 was budgeted for Civil Service hearings for both  
15 municipal and police civil service hearings; and

16 WHEREAS, several hearings were pending before these boards; and

17 WHEREAS, these appropriations were insufficient to conclude these  
18 matters; and

19 WHEREAS, two additional appeals and one appeal currently underway  
20 remain to be heard; and

21 WHEREAS, the Animal Control Officer has indicated an emergency situation  
22 for its incinerator; and

23 WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Operating Reserve Account  
24 # 20950-95101 to satisfy these funding requirements.

25 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it  
26 does hereby authorize the transfer of \$24,500.00 from reserve account # 20950-95101  
27 as follows:

- 28 1. \$10,000.00 for additional civil service hearings restricted to attorney  
29 for attendance at employee appeal hearings and court reporters for  
30 employee appeal hearings only.  
31 2. \$14,500.00 for Animal Control immediate incinerator repairs.

7 shall notify the Slidell City Council Office, the Mayor, and the City Attorney immediately  
8 of the intent to select any legal representation.
