5 **RESOLUTION R94-53**

7 A resolution designating certain city revenues derived from gaming activities
8 for the upkeep and maintenance of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration
9 (NASA) building on Gause Boulevard, Slidell, Louisiana.
10

11 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell will acquire the NASA building at the
12 intersection of Gause Boulevard and Robert Boulevard on December 14, 1994; and

13 WHEREAS, the preferred use of the facility is to foster higher education, or
14 in the alternative, to promote economic development in the Slidell community; and

15 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council chooses to designate certain City funds
16 for the temporary operation and maintenance of the NASA facility; and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell receives state shared revenues from video
18 poker gaming machines within the City of Slidell; and

19 WHEREAS, said gaming revenues received by the City range from one
20 hundred fifty to two hundred fifty thousand (\$150,000.00-\$250,000.00) dollars per annum;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana had reviewed the possibility that certain
23 lottery proceeds would be designated for higher education; and

24 WHEREAS, said dedication has not yet occurred.

25 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
26 does hereby designate its gaming proceeds derived from video poker machines within the
27 City of Slidell as a temporary funding source for the maintenance and operation of the
28 NASA facility, with the expressed purpose of using these proceeds to bring higher
29 education, or in the alternative, to promote economic development within the City of
30 Slidell.
