9 A resolution requesting assistance from the State of Louisiana for the
10 cleanup of the Southern Shipyard hazardous waste site, Slidell, Louisiana.

11 WHEREAS, Southern Shipyard has been determined by the EPA and DEQ
12 to be a hazardous waste site and subject to environmental cleanup through the Federal
13 Superfund Program; and

14 WHEREAS, said cleanup program now requires a ten percent (10%) match
15 from the local level; and

16 WHEREAS, it is estimated to cost \$25 Million Dollars to complete the
17 necessary work at the hazardous site; and

18 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell needs assistance in connection therewith.

19 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
20 does hereby request assistance from the State of Louisiana and cooperation from our
21 legislative delegation to provide the ten percent (10%) matching funds necessary for the
22 cleanup of the hazardous waste site identified as the Southern Shipbuilding property in
23 Slidell, Louisiana.
