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5 **RESOLUTION R95-06**
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7 A resolution requesting the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the
8 Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) recommend the best disposal method for
9 hazardous waste material located at the Southern Shipyard Site, Slidell, Louisiana.

10 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a second site identified on the United
11 States Superfund listing for hazardous waste material cleanup and disposal; and

12 WHEREAS, numerous meetings have been held to ascertain public input
13 into the preferred method of disposal of said waste; and


14 WHEREAS, the EPA and DEQ have the technical training, skills, and
15 equipment to determine which method of clean-up would be in the best interest of our
16 community; and

17 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council asks that the herein stated agencies
18 take into consideration all the public input, petitions, and written and verbal comments
19 regarding said disposal.

20 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
21 does hereby call upon the EPA and DEQ to dispose of the hazardous waste material at
22 the Southern Shipyard site in such a manner as they determine to be safe, most efficient,
23 and in the best interest of our community.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at the conclusion of the Southern
25 Shipyard waste disposal, no other hazardous waste material will be processed in any
26 manner in the City of Slidell, and the Bayou Bonfouca incinerator shall be permanently
27 closed.
