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6 **RESOLUTION R95-16**  
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9 A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the City of  
10 Slidell, State of Louisiana, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of revenue and  
11 general obligation bonds therewith, making application to the State Bond Commission in  
12 connection therewith and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

13 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Slidell City Council (the "Governing Authority"),  
14 acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

15 **SECTION 1. Election Call.** Subject to the approval of the State Bond  
16 Commission, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 33 of the  
17 Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, Sub-Part C, Part I, Chapter 10, Title 33  
18 and Sub-Part A, Part III, Chapter 4, Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,  
19 as amended, the applicable provisions of Chapter 5, Chapter 6-A and Chapter 6-B of Title  
20 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and  
21 statutory authority, a special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City  
22 on **SATURDAY, JULY 15, 1995**, between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m., and eight  
23 o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541, and at the said  
24 election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at  
25 the said election under the Constitution and laws of this State and the Constitution of the  
26 United States, the following propositions, to-wit:

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30 **WATERWORKS AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS**

32 **SUMMARY:** AUTHORITY TO ISSUE 20 YEAR REVENUE BONDS IN THE  
33 AMOUNT OF \$6,400,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND  
34 ACQUIRING IMPROVEMENTS AND EXTENSION TO THE COMBINED  
35 WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND SEWER SYSTEM OF SAID CITY.

37 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, incur debt and issue revenue  
38 bonds to the amount of Six Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars  
39 (\$6,400,000) to run twenty (20) years from the date thereof, with interest at  
40 a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per annum, for the  
41 purpose of constructing and acquiring improvements and extensions to the  
42 combined waterworks system and sewer system of said City, said bonds to  
43 be secured by and payable as to principal and interest solely from the  
44 income and revenues to be derived from the operation of said combined  
45 revenue producing public utility, pursuant to the provisions of Sub-Part C,  
46 Part I, Chapter 10, Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950?

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8 STREET AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

10 SUMMARY: AUTHORITY TO ISSUE 20 YEAR GENERAL OBLIGATION  
11 BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,045,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
12 CONSTRUCTING, PAVING AND IMPROVING STREETS AND ROADS  
13 INCLUDING NECESSARY ATTENDANT ROAD DRAINAGE IN SAID CITY,  
14 TITLE TO WHICH SHALL BE IN THE PUBLIC.  
15

16 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, incur debt and issue bonds to  
17 the amount of Seven Million Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$7,045,000) to  
18 run twenty (20) years from the date thereof, with interest at a rate or rates  
19 not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per annum, for the purpose of  
20 constructing, paving and improving streets and roads including necessary  
21 attendant road drainage in said City, title to which shall be in the public,  
22 which bonds will be general obligations of said City and will be payable from  
23 ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner provided by  
24 Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974,  
25 and statutory authority supplemental thereto?

29 DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS  
30

31 SUMMARY: AUTHORITY TO ISSUE 20 YEAR GENERAL OBLIGATION  
32 BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,555,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
33 CONSTRUCTING DRAINS, DRAINAGE CANALS AND PUMPING  
34 STATIONS IN SAID CITY AND ACQUIRING THE NECESSARY  
35 EQUIPMENT THEREFOR, TITLE TO WHICH SHALL BE IN THE PUBLIC.  
36

37 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, incur debt and issue bonds to  
38 the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars  
39 (\$2,555,000) to run twenty (20) years from the date thereof, with interest at  
40 a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per annum, for the  
41 purpose of constructing drains, drainage canals and pumping stations in  
42 said City and acquiring the necessary equipment therefor, title to which shall  
43 be in the public, which bonds will be general obligations of said City and will  
44 be payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner  
45 provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of  
46 Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental thereto?  
47

48 SECTION 2. Publication of Notice of Election. A Notice of Special Election shall  
49 be published in "The Slidell Sentry News," a daily newspaper of general circulation within  
50 the City, published in Slidell, Louisiana, and being the official journal of the Governing  
51 Authority, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made  
52 not less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date fixed  
53 for election, which Notice shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as "Exhibit A"  
54 and incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

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6 SECTION 3. Canvass. This Governing Authority, acting as the governing authority  
7 of the City, shall meet at its regular meeting place, the City Hall, 2055 Second Street,  
8 Slidell, Louisiana, on **TUESDAY, JULY 25, 1995, at SIX-THIRTY (6:30) O'CLOCK P.M.**,  
9 and shall then and there in open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the  
10 returns and declare the results of the said special election.

11 SECTION 4. Polling Places. The polling places set forth in the aforesaid Notice  
12 of Special Election are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said  
13 election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be the  
14 same persons as those designated in accordance with law.

15 SECTION 5. Election Commissioners; Voting Machines. The officers designated  
16 to serve as Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section 4 hereof,  
17 or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance with La.  
18 R.S. 18:1287, shall hold the said special election as herein provided, and shall make due  
19 returns of said election for the meeting of the Governing Authority to be held on Tuesday,  
20 July 25, 1995, as provided in Section 3 hereof. All registered voters in the City are  
21 entitled to vote at said special election and voting machines shall be used thereat.

22 SECTION 6. Authorization of Officers. The Council Administrator/Clerk of the  
23 Council of the Governing Authority is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to  
24 arrange for and to furnish to said election officers in ample time for the holding of said  
25 election, the necessary equipment, forms and other paraphernalia essential to the proper  
26 holding of said election and the Council Administrator/Clerk of the Council and/or  
27 President of the Council of the Governing Authority are further authorized, empowered  
28 and directed to take any and all further action required by State and/or Federal law to  
29 arrange for the election, including but not limited to, appropriate submission to the Federal  
30 Department of Justice under Section 5 of the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as  
31 amended.  
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
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6 SECTION 7. Furnishing Election Call to Election Officials. Certified copies of this

7 resolution shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Commissioner of Elections,  
8 the Clerk of Court and Ex-Officio Parish Custodian of Voting Machines in and for the  
9 Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and the Registrar of Voters in and for said  
10 Parish, as notification of the special election herein called in order that each may prepare  
11 for said election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

12 SECTION 8. Application to State Bond Commission. Application is made to the

13 State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the aforesaid special election  
14 as herein provided, and in the event said election carries for further consent and authority  
15 to issue, sell and deliver the Bonds provided for therein, and a certified copy of this  
16 resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission on behalf of this Governing  
17 Authority, together with a letter requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this  
18 application.
