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5 **RESOLUTION R95-21**  
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7 A resolution concurring with Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and  
8 Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) recommendation to dispose of Southern  
9 Shipyard hazardous waste material by incineration.

10 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is the location of an ongoing Superfund Site  
11 for the disposal of hazardous material by incineration; and

12 WHEREAS, a second hazardous site has been identified in the City of  
13 Slidell area known as Southern Shipyard; and

14 WHEREAS, the recent flood waters caused dangerous discharge from  
15 Southern Shipyard into Bayou Bonfouca; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell could not afford to remediate this situation any  
17 time in the near or distant future; and

18 WHEREAS, federal money and help is available at this time; and

19 WHEREAS, the EPA and DEQ has expressed a preference to dispose of  
20 this hazardous material at the existing incineration site on Bayou Bonfouca; and

21 WHEREAS, it is estimated that six to eight months will be required to  
22 complete the incineration.

23 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it  
24 concurs with the EPA and DEQ preference of disposing of hazardous waste material from  
25 the Southern Shipyard site by incineration at the existing Bayou Bonfouca incinerator in  
26 Slidell, Louisiana.
