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RESOLUTION R95-33

A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of revenue bonds therein, making application to the State Bond Commission in connection therewith and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

SECTION 1. Election Call. Subject to the approval of the State Bond Commission, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, Sub-Part C, Part I, Chapter 10, Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, the applicable provisions of Chapter 5, Chapter 6-A and Chapter 6-B of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, a special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City on **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 21, 1995**, between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m., and eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541, and at the said election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and laws of this State and the Constitution of the United States, the following proposition, to-wit:

SUMMARY: AUTHORITY TO ISSUE 20 YEAR REVENUE BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,400,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND ACQUIRING IMPROVEMENTS AND EXTENSION TO THE COMBINED WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND SEWER SYSTEM OF SAID CITY.

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5 SECTION 2. Publication of Notice of Election. A Notice of Special Election
6 shall be published in "The Slidell Sentry News," a daily newspaper of general circulation within
7 the City, published in Slidell, Louisiana, and being the official journal of the Governing
8 Authority, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not
9 less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date fixed for election,
10 which Notice shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated
11 herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

12 SECTION 3. Canvass. This Governing Authority, acting as the governing

19 election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be the
20 same persons as those designated in accordance with law.

21 SECTION 5. Election Commissioners; Voting Machines. The officers

6 SECTION 7. Furnishing Election Call to Election Officials. Certified copies of
7 this resolution shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Commissioner of Elections,
8 the Clerk of Court and Ex-Officio Parish Custodian of Voting Machines in and for the Parish
9 of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and the Registrar of Voters in and for said Parish, as
10 notification of the special election herein called in order that each may prepare for said
11 election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

12 SECTION 8. Application to State Bond Commission. Application is made to
13 the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the aforesaid special election
14 as herein provided, and in the event said election carries for further consent and authority to
15 issue, sell and deliver the Bonds provided for therein, and a certified copy of this resolution
16 shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission on behalf of this Governing Authority,
17 together with a letter requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this application.


