A resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development for the renovation of the Slidell Railroad Depot.

WHEREAS, the City has already dedicated \$51,000.00 to be used as a local match; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute an agreement with the State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development, for the renovation of the Depot according to the terms and conditions as stated herein and attached hereto.
