A resolution requesting support for The United Way.

WHEREAS, The United Way's mission is to organize the capacity of people to care  
for one another; and

WHEREAS, The United Way effectively targets the needs of the poor, disabled and  
needy, better than most other agencies in getting money to them; and

WHEREAS, The United Way is an organized approach to addressing our  
community's problems; and

WHEREAS, recently our area was helped by The United Way in yet another way  
during the recent natural disaster that devastated our community in May 1995; and

WHEREAS, The United Way agencies of the Red Cross and Salvation Army  
directly served our community in an outstanding way; and

WHEREAS, during the 1994 United Way campaign \$239,345 was raised in St.  
Tammany Parish; and


WHEREAS, the City of Slidell and its surrounding area has repeatedly benefited  
from The United Way, evidenced by the fact that during the 1993-94 year approximately 19,104  
residences of St. Tammany Parish received over \$684,000 of services from United Way agencies;  
and

WHEREAS, there are United Way agencies that serve our area, not to mention  
other non-profit organizations that provide services to our City and community; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$3.5 to \$4 million was expended in St. Tammany during  
the May 1995 flooding disaster by United Way agencies; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Slidell encourages its  
citizens and employees to support The United Way effort and support those agencies that help  
our community.
