9 A resolution asking that the United States Congressional Delegation to include
10 funds for the Southern Shipyard cleanup, Slidell, Louisiana, in the Environmental Protection
11 Agency's budget for the coming year.

13 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a Superfund cleanup program underway; and

14 WHEREAS, said program has an incinerator on-site to dispose of hazardous
15 waste material; and


16 WHEREAS, another Superfund Site has been identified in the Slidell
17 Community; and

18 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell feels it would be most efficient to utilize the
19 existing incinerator for Southern Shipyard hazardous waste; and

20 WHEREAS, Federal budget cuts under consideration could impact the
21 availability of funds to complete the Southern Shipyard disposal.

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
23 hereby call upon its United States Congressional Delegation to include necessary
24 appropriations to complete the clean-up of hazardous material at the Southern Shipyard site
25 in Slidell, Louisiana.
