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6 **RESOLUTION R95-62**
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9 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has submitted an application for funding of
10 the Schneider Canal Pumping Station flood control improvement project under the
11 Statewide Flood Control Program; and

12 WHEREAS, the State's share of the project funds has been made available
13 and the City of Slidell has available its local matching share of the project funds in an
14 amount of not less than thirty (30%) percent, and

15 WHEREAS, at the request of the City of Slidell, Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. has
16 prepared plans and specifications for said project, which plans and specifications are
17 designated by State Project No.'s 576-52-0005, 576-52-0006, 576-52-0007, and 576-52-
18 0008, being phases 1 through 4, respectively, of State Project No. 576-52-0004; and

19 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has reviewed the final plans, specifications,
20 and cost estimate and accepts them as submitted and the Department of Transportation
21 and Development has reviewed the final plans, specifications, and cost estimate and has
22 approved them inasmuch as they comply with the requirements of the Statewide Flood
23 Control Program; and

24 WHEREAS, all necessary servitudes, rights-of-way, spoil disposal areas,
25 rights of ingress and egress, and the means thereof have been acquired by the City of
26 Slidell and the titles thereto are valid and indefeasible; and

27 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has obtained all necessary permits required
28 for the construction of this project; and

29 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has agreed to accomplish all necessary
30 utilities, fence and other facilities relocations and alterations made necessary by this
31 project; and

32 WHEREAS, the Official Journal for the City of Slidell is the Slidell Sentry
33 News, whose mailing address is P. O. Box 910, Slidell, LA 70459, and whose telephone
34 number is (504-643-4918); and
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5 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to advertise for competitive bids in
6 accordance with LRS 38:2212 et seq for the award of a contract in the name of the City
7 of Slidell and furnish engineering services during the progress of the work.

8 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council in Special
9 session assembled on this 18th day of October, 1995, that the Department of
10 Transportation and Development be and hereby is requested to authorize the City of
11 Slidell to advertise for competitive bids in accordance with LRS 38:2212 et seq for the
12 award of a contract in the name of the City of Slidell covering the aforesaid
13 improvements.

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and Development
15 be and hereby is assured that all necessary servitudes, rights-of way, rights of ingress
16 and egress and the means thereof have been obtained by the City of Slidell and the titles
17 thereto are valid and indefeasible and the City of Slidell expressly agrees to defend any
18 action for the failure of any servitude, right-of-way, right of ingress or egress, and the City
19 of Slidell does hereby assume complete responsibility for providing engineering services
20 during construction and the maintenance and upkeep of the project after construction.

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and Development
22 be and hereby is assured that all required permits have been obtained by the City of
23 Slidell.


24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and Development
25 be and hereby is assured that the City of Slidell has available its local matching funds in
26 an amount not less than thirty (30%) percent and which combined with the State's share
27 is sufficient to ensure construction of this project.

28 BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Slidell will and hereby does assume
29 complete responsibility for all utilities, fence, and other facilities relocations and alterations
30 made necessary by this project.

31 BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Slidell does hereby save and hold
32 harmless the Department of Transportation and Development against any loss or damage
33 of any kind incident to or occasioned by activities undertaken in pursuance of this

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5 agreement and expressly agrees to defend any suit brought against the Department of
6 Transportation and Development, and pay any judgement which may result from said suit
7 as it relates to this project.
