RESOLUTION R95-69

A resolution requesting funds for Airport improvements.

WHEREAS, Section 131 of Title 2 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 provides that cities, towns, parishes, and other political subdivisions of this State may separately or jointly acquire, establish, construct, expand, own, lease, control, equip, improve, maintain, operate, regulate, and police airports and landing fields for the use of aircraft; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development, Division of Aviation (formerly the LA DOTD-OAPT) is charged by Section 6 of Title 2 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 with the responsibility for the development of aviation facilities within the State to foster air commerce and to safeguard the interests of those engaged in all phases of the aviation industry and of the general public; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the comprehensive aviation development program of the LA DOTD, Division of Aviation and the Federal Aviation Administration, the City of Slidell of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, has completed a Five-Year Capital Improvement Program and Master Plan which outlines the specific development of the Slidell Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana is desirous of implementing a portion of the Capital Improvement Program and Master Plan recommendations which provide for critically needed improvements to substantially improve the safety and usability of the Airport, but does not have sufficient funds of its own to finance all of the matching funds required for completing the needed improvements; and

WHEREAS, the LA DOTD, Division of Aviation is authorized by the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 to expend funds for the construction or enlargement of airports for the safety and advancement of aeronautics.
