9 A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the results
10 of the special election held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, on Saturday,
11 November 18, 1995, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of general obligation
12 bonds.

14 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Slidell City Council (the "Governing Authority"),
15 acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

16 **SECTION 1. Canvass.** This Governing Authority does now proceed in open
17 and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election
18 held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, (the "City"), on **SATURDAY, NOVEMBER**
19 **18, 1995**, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of general obligation bonds, and
20 said Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns and
21 declare the result of the special election.

22 **SECTION 2. Proces Verbal.** A Proces Verbal of the canvass of the returns
23 of said election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the
24 Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office.

25 **SECTION 3. Promulgation of Election Results.** The results of said election
26 shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.

6 AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SLIDELL, STATE OF LOUISIANA,
7 ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 1995.

9 BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on Wednesday, November 22,
10 1995, at TWO (2:00) o'clock p.m., at its regular meeting place, the City Hall, 2055 Second
11 Street, Slidell, Louisiana, the Slidell City Council (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the
12 governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), and being the
13 authority ordering the special election held therein on Saturday, November 18, 1995, with
14 the following members present:

20 did, in open and public session, examine the official certified tabulations of votes cast at
21 the said election, and did examine and canvass the returns of the said election, there
22 having been submitted at said election the following proposition, to wit:

28 SUMMARY: AUTHORITY TO ISSUE 20 YEAR GENERAL
29 OBLIGATION BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,500,000 FOR THE
30 PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND ACQUIRING DRAINS,
31 DRAINAGE CANALS, PUMPS AND PUMPING STATIONS AND
32 OTHER DRAINAGE FACILITIES IN CONNECTION THEREWITH IN
33 SAID CITY INCLUDING RETENTION PONDS, AND ACQUIRING
34 THE NECESSARY SITES AND EQUIPMENT THEREFOR, TITLE
35 TO WHICH SHALL BE IN THE PUBLIC.

37 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, incur debt and issue
38 bonds to the amount of Nine Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
39 (\$9,500,000) to run twenty (20) years from the date thereof, with
40 interest at a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per
41 annum, for the purpose of making drainage improvements, including,
42 without limitations, retention ponds, constructing drains, drainage
43 canals and pumping stations in said City and acquiring the
44 necessary equipment therefor, title to which shall be in the public,
45 which bonds will be general obligations of said City and will be
46 payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the
47 manner provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the
48 State of Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental
49 thereto?

52 There was found by said count and canvass that the following votes had

5 The polling places above specified being the only polling places designated at which
6 to hold the said election, it was therefore shown that there was a total of 5,877 votes cast **IN**
7 **FAVOR OF** the Proposition and a total of 2,860 votes cast **AGAINST** the Proposition, as
8 hereinabove set forth, and that there was a majority of 3,017 votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the
9 Proposition as hereinabove set forth.

11 Therefore, the Governing Authority did declare and proclaim and does hereby declare
12 and proclaim in open and public session that the Proposition as hereinabove set forth was duly
13 **CARRIED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the said special election
14 held in the City on Saturday, November 18, 1995.
