8 A resolution restating public policy, reporting requirements, and record
9 keeping for public projects within the City of Slidell.
10

11 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has undertaken more than thirty-five million
12 dollars (\$35,000,000) in Capital Improvement Projects in the last ten (10) years; and

13 WHEREAS, the City has always had a public record's policy which permits
14 and encourages the inspection of City records by members of the public; and

15 WHEREAS, public accountability has been and will continue to be of utmost
16 importance to Slidell City officials; and

17 WHEREAS, the Slidell City government has an unblemished record for
18 public reporting and has won numerous awards therefor; and

19 WHEREAS, existing City policy provides for specific line items within each
20 project for cost identification; and

21 WHEREAS, reserves are established to facilitate the completion of projects
22 and said reserves are retained and unspent until all projects are completed; and

23 WHEREAS, the Mayor of Slidell has always been extremely cooperative in
24 keeping the City Council and the public informed on the progress of all Capital Projects.

25 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
26 does hereby state that existing policies and procedures for public accountability go
27 beyond the public law requirements to ensure the safety of City funds.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Slidell has an excellent and
29 uncorrupt reputation for public accountability and deals with all matters in a forthright and
30 public manner.
