RESOLUTION R96-17

A resolution requesting and authorizing the City Administration to establish standards and seek proposals for ambulance services within the corporate limits of the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:4791 permits the local Governing Authority of each municipality within the state of Louisiana to adopt ordinances for the regulation of ambulance services operated by private individuals or companies; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council seeks to have high quality emergency medical care, and acceptable response times essential to the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, emergency services may include emergency medical services and any and all aspects attendant to ambulance operations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that in accordance with Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:4791 the Slidell City Council does hereby request the Mayor of the City of Slidell to recommend standards for an ordinance regulating ambulance services within the corporate limits of the City of Slidell and to thereafter solicit proposals for said services.
