**RESOLUTION R96-21**

A resolution requesting the appointment of a five-member steering committee by the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury, the City of Slidell, and the Town of Pearl River to develop guidelines, goals, objectives, boundaries, and strategy for the St. Tammany Parish Gravity Drainage District No. 3 and matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury, the Slidell City Council, and the City of Pearl River desire to form a Gravity Drainage District for portions of eastern St. Tammany Parish; and


WHEREAS, such a district was initially formed by the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury in 1967; and


WHEREAS, enabling legislation could be amended for said Gravity Drainage District to accomplish present goals and objectives, and to provide for district appointees by the City of Slidell and Town of Pearl River.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, as follows:

1. A five-member steering committee shall be appointed consisting of two representatives from the City of Slidell, two from the Police Jury, and one from the City of Pearl River.
2. Said steering committee shall make recommendations to include, but not limited to, district boundaries, goals, objectives, purpose, and prospective funding and pertinent amendments to the enabling legislation.
3. These recommendations shall be reviewed by the Slidell City Council, the Police Jury, and the Town of Pearl River and enabling legislation would be amended to accomplish the established purpose.
4. Upon the amendment of the enabling legislation, the five-member steering committee may be appointed as commissioners for the St. Tammany Parish Gravity Drainage District No. 3.
