RESOLUTION R96-32

A resolution suspending the enforcement of plastic (only) go-cups during
City of Slidell Mardi Gras parades during the month of January 1997, as prohibited by
Ordinance No. 2710.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2710 was adopted by the Slidell City Council on
October 22, 1996; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance prohibited the removal of alcoholic beverages
in open containers from all establishments licensed to dispense alcoholic beverages for
consumption by-the-drink; and

WHEREAS, there are certain Mardi Gras parades and other functions in the
City of Slidell that from time to time the use of plastic (only) go-cups should be permitted;
and

WHEREAS, Item No. 96-12-1906 introduced by the Slidell City Council at
the December 3, 1996, meeting provides for exemptions for go-cups as stated herein;
and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on said item shall be heard on January 14,
1997, wherein if adopted, the law would be amended to permit the use of plastic (only)
go-cups for such City sponsored or licensed events.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
does hereby suspend the prohibition against plastic (only) go-cups as prohibited by
Ordinance No. 2710 for all Mardi Gras parades and other City licensed or permitted
functions during the month of January 1997.
