

Introduced December 17, 1996, by Councilwoman Livaudais, seconded by Councilman Callahan (both by request of Administration)

RESOLUTION R96-34

A resolution ratifying Ordinance No. 2717 adopted at the December 3, 1996, Slidell City Council meeting, to amend millage rates not in excess of prior year's maximum as shown on official assessment rolls of the year 1996 and restating same.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Slidell in the Parish of St. Tammany, Louisiana, in a public hearing held on December 3, 1996, and conducted in accordance with the open meetings law, the City voted to increase the millage rate(s), but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rate(s), on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 1996, and, when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied; said millage rate(s) are as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Assessor of the Parish of St. Tammany shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 1996 the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said parish shall collect and remit the same to said City in accordance with law.

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5 The foregoing resolution was read in full, the roll was called on the adoption
6 thereof, and the resolution was adopted by no less than a two-thirds majority of the total
7 membership of the taxing authority voting in favor as required by Paragraph (B) of Section
8 23 of Article VII of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and Paragraph B of Section 1705 of
9 Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.


