RESOLUTION R97-15

A resolution of the Slidell City Council of Slidell, Louisiana, supporting the efforts of the Greater Slidell Area Chamber of Commerce and St. Tammany West Chamber of Commerce in creating, funding, operating, and maintaining a multi-purpose/performing arts center in St. Tammany Parish to serve the growing needs of organizations on the Northshore of Lake Pontchartrain.

WHEREAS, the Greater Slidell Area Chamber of Commerce and the St. Tammany West Chamber of Commerce have come together to initiate two major independent studies to determine the feasibility of creating a multi-purpose/performing arts center in St. Tammany Parish to serve the growing needs of organizations who would use such a facility on the Northshore in St. Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, this proposed multi-purpose/performing arts facility would seek to accommodate large assemblies, graduations, Mardi Gras balls, conventions, concerts, trade shows, symphonic performances, operas, plays, musicals, athletic events, livestock shows and equestrian events; and

WHEREAS, the growing population in St. Tammany Parish has created the need for such a facility to serve the entire St. Tammany Parish area;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL that it does hereby fully support the efforts of the Greater Slidell Area Chamber of Commerce and the St. Tammany West Chamber of Commerce in the creation of a multi-purpose/performing arts center in St. Tammany Parish to serve the growing needs of organizations who would use such a facility on the Northshore of Lake Pontchartrain.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does hereby call upon the assistance of its state and federal legislative delegations for funding, and to support the efforts of all individuals and groups involved in this process to make this multipurposes/performing arts center in St. Tammany Parish become a reality.
