RESOLUTION R97-17

A resolution opposing all tolls on the Interstate Highway 10 Twin Span between New Orleans and St. Tammany Parish and further requesting legislative amendments to House Bill 411 whereby any new toll authorities would be limited to new construction only, and matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council opposes any toll charges on the Interstate Highway 10 Twin Span and on U. S. Highway 11 bridge from Orleans Parish to St. Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 411 which permits the creation of toll authorities is vague with reference to the roadway upon which tolls could be levied.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby call upon the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury and the State Legislative delegation to prohibit the imposition of any toll charges on Interstate Highway 10 Twin Span and U. S. Highway 11 bridges from Orleans Parish to St. Tammany Parish.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council requests House Bill 411 be amended to permit the levying of toll charges on only newly constructed roadways, and that the establishment of toll authorities require local governmental approval.
