RESOLUTION R97-21

A resolution requesting the Mayor to provide monthly reports on all activity associated with the Major Capital Improvement Programs for the City of Slidell, including sewer, water, fire hydrant, drainage, street, ditch maintenance contracts, and other improvements related thereto.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has undertaken more than a \$28 million (twenty-eight million dollar) Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, these improvements include sewer, water, drainage, streets, and other projects associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, each project is referred to by number and phase and it is difficult to match the individual projects with phases; and


WHEREAS, several projects have bids that are less than estimated amounts and others have bids that are more than estimated amounts; and

WHEREAS, change orders are frequent and difficult to keep up with project costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request the Mayor under Section 3-07 Powers and Duties of the Mayor, Paragraph 7, of the City of Slidell Home Rule Charter, to provide a written report to the Slidell City Council office on the last working day of each month detailing the status of each project, its costs estimates, its bid amount, change orders associated with the project, total estimated amount over or under budget, and all other matters in connection therewith deemed pertinent by the Mayor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said report is requested to enable the City Council to conduct its Councilmanic function.
