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10 A resolution requesting State monies via the Capital Outlay Act for
11 improvements to Slidell Olde Towne.
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13 WHEREAS, Slidell Olde Towne is one of the City of Slidell's most important
14 assets and tourist attractions; and

15 WHEREAS, Slidell Olde Towne can further benefit the public with needed
16 improvements; and

17 WHEREAS, improvements to Slidell Olde Towne for Old Towne Street Decor
18 have been identified and estimated to cost Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars
19 (\$370,000).

20 WHEREAS, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) of the estimated
21 Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$370,000) cost for this project has been appropriated
22 in the City's 1998 Capital Budget; and

23 WHEREAS, there is no bond funding, other than State general obligation
24 bond funding, sufficient to fund the Capital Outlay request attached; and

25 WHEREAS, all local options for funding for these Capital Outlay requests
26 through taxation, special assessments, loans, bond or other resources have been
27 considered and rejected as not being feasible or readily acceptable at this time; and

28 WHEREAS, there is no additional funding for non-recurring appropriations
29 within the City's Capital Budget; and

30 WHEREAS, no surplus funds are available for these purposes.

31 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the
32 preparation of a request for State monies via the Capital Outlay Act for improvements to
33 Slidell Olde Towne is approved and supported.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is hereby
35 authorized to represent the City in all matters in connection herewith.
