WHEREAS, information is available to assist residents with rat control.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request the Administration to make residents of District F and District G aware of recommendations for rat control and prevention with material provided from local and state government investigators of the infestation.
