VERBAL RESOLUTION R97-01

A resolution requesting Administration of the City of Slidell to provide for an inventory of immovable property

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1552 dated November 9, 1982, was adopted by the Slidell City Council; and

WHEREAS, the intent of said ordinance was to provide for an inventory of all immovable properties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request the Administration to investigate the cost, feasibility and requirements to have the City Attorney obtain a certified true copy of each deed to immovable property owned by the City of Slidell, and for said deeds to be filed by the City Attorney with the Department of Planning and with the Clerk of the Slidell City Council, for the Clerk to file said deeds in the archives of the City Council, and for the Planning Department to maintain and establish an inventory of all immovable property owned by the City of Slidell and shall also include in said inventory all City of Slidell easements, right-of-ways, and servitudes. Provided, however, that immovable property acquired by the City of Slidell at tax sales shall be exempt from the provisions of this section."
