9 A resolution opposing the proposed Internet Tax Freedom Act by the 105th
10 Congress of the United States of America.
11

12 WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives has under
13 consideration Bill H. R. 1054 and the United States Senate is considering Bill S. 442
14 prohibiting the imposition of taxes on Internet or interactive computer services commerce;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, said bills would deprive State and local governments from sales
17 tax revenues generated by products sold via the Internet; and

18 WHEREAS, local municipalities are dependant upon sales tax dollars as a
19 major source of revenue.

20 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
21 hereby oppose the Internet Tax Freedom Act as it will deprive local governments of
22 necessary sales tax dollars which would normally accrue to them through the sale of goods
23 and services.
