9 A resolution requesting Two Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars  
10 (\$290,000.00) via the Capital Outlay Act for improvements to the City of Slidell's Schneider  
11 Canal Drainage Pump Station Generators.  
12

13 WHEREAS, the drainage basin served by the Schneider Canal Pump Station  
14 covers approximately 1,300 acres and serves a population of approximately Four  
15 Thousand Four Hundred (4,400) persons; and

16 WHEREAS, the provision of backup electrical power through the means of  
17 diesel power generators will ensure the operation of the station during power outages; and

18 WHEREAS, the operation of the station during power outages and rain  
19 events is critical to flood prevention of the drainage basin; and

20 WHEREAS, the Schneider Canal Pump Station Generators have been  
21 identified and estimated to cost Six Hundred Seven Thousand Five Hundred Forty Dollars  
22 (\$607,540.00); and

23 WHEREAS, Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Forty  
24 Dollars (\$317,540.00) will be appropriated in the City of Slidell 1998-99 Capital Budget;  
25 and

26 WHEREAS, there is no other bond funding, other than State general  
27 obligation bond funding, sufficient to fund the Capital Outlay request; and

28 WHEREAS, all local funding options through taxation, special assessments,  
29 loans, bond or other resources have been considered and rejected as not being feasible  
30 or readily acceptable at this time; and

31 WHEREAS, there is no additional finding for non-recurring appropriations  
32 within the City's Capital Budget; and


33 WHEREAS, no surplus funds are available for these purposes.

34 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the  
35 preparation of a request for State money via the Capital Outlay Act for the City of Slidell's  
36 Schneider Canal Pump Station Generators is approved and supported.
