10 A resolution requesting the Mayor of the City of Slidell to begin a district day
11 work program (modified old D-Day).

13 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell had a D-Day program wherein most municipal
14 City workers concentrated their work efforts in a particular district on one day during the
15 month; and

16 WHEREAS, this work day provided an opportunity for Council Members to
17 get specific work done in their district and to interact with employees; and

18 WHEREAS, said work day program would be optional with Council Members
19 and would rotate through the seven councilmanic districts; and

20 ~~WHEREAS, each Council member and the two Council-At- Large Members~~
21 could participate and attend each such work day; and

22 WHEREAS, the City Administration's staff would develop a list of work to be
23 performed for the work day in each district; and

24 WHEREAS, \$1,500.00 is required as supplemental funding for the program
25 and will be reallocated from the 1999 Operating Reserve.

26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
27 hereby request the Mayor to establish a district work day program in accordance with the
28 conditions set out herein.
