9 A resolution of the Slidell City Council expressing its appreciation and
10 gratitude to all City employees and City Officials for the excellent work effort during
11 Hurricane Georges.

12 WHEREAS, the violent and dangerous hurricane named Georges was
13 bearing down on the southeast Louisiana Gulf Coast during the week of September 20,
14 1998; and

15 WHEREAS, City employees made advanced preparations for the
16 approaching storm; and


17 WHEREAS, on September 25-29, 1998, the fury of Hurricane Georges was
18 upon the City of Slidell; and

19 WHEREAS, Georges made landfall just east of Slidell, Louisiana, on
20 September 27, 1998, with hurricane force winds, rain, and tidal surges substantially above
21 normal; and


22 WHEREAS, municipal City employees, municipal Police employees,
23 Department Heads, and Elected Officials were separated from their families and worked
24 untiringly to protect the life and property of the citizens of Slidell, and did so on a twenty-
25 four hour basis during crisis and hazardous situations.

26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
27 hereby extend a "*genuine thank you*" to all City employees, Police employees, Department
28 Heads, and City Officials who worked courageously during Hurricane Georges, and does
29 further state its appreciation for a "*job well done.*"
