Rakes.

WHEREAS, the drainage basin served by the Schneider Canal Pump Station covers approximately One Thousand Three Hundred (1,300) acres and serves a population of approximately Four Thousand Four Hundred (4,400) persons; and

WHEREAS, the provision of backup electrical power through the means of diesel power generators will ensure the operation of the station during power outages; and

WHEREAS, the operation of the station during power outages and rain events is critical to flood prevention of the drainage basin; and

WHEREAS, the trash rakes will ensure that pump low level alarms will not shut down the pumps; and

WHEREAS, the Schneider Canal Pump Station Backup Generators and Trash Rakes have been identified and estimated to cost One Million One Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$1,197,050.00); and

WHEREAS, Two Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Two Dollars (\$299,262) will be appropriated in the City of Slidell 1998-99 Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, there is no other bond funding, other than State general obligation bond funding, sufficient to fund the Capital Outlay request; and

WHEREAS, all local funding options through taxation, special assessments, loans, bond or other resources have been considered and rejected as not being feasible or readily acceptable at this time; and

WHEREAS, there is no additional funding for non-recurring appropriations within the City's Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, no surplus funds are available for these purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the preparation of a request for State money via the Capital Outlay Act for the City of Slidell's
