13 WHEREAS, there is presently pending against the City of Slidell legal action
14 entitled "Sheryl Sechrest v. City of Slidell, et al," bearing docket number 96-14342 of the
15 22nd Judicial District Court; and


16 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute 13:5105 (D) provides for the waiver
17 of the prohibition against a jury trial in an action against a political subdivision of the State;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, a trial by jury in the Sheryl Sechrest v. City of Slidell, et al action
20 could be in the best interest of the City and the other defendants.


21 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Slidell does hereby
22 waive the prohibition against a jury trial in the matter of Sheryl Sechrest v. City of Slidell,
23 et al, docket number 96-14342 of the 22nd Judicial District Court.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the specific intent of the City of Slidell
25 that the waiver of the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statute 13:5105 as respects the
26 prohibition against a trial by jury apply solely and exclusively to the matter entitled "Sheryl
27 Sechrest v. City of Slidell, et al," and that this resolution shall not apply to any other legal
28 action pending against the City now or in the future.
