A resolution urging Governor Foster and the Louisiana State Legislature to support and fund the Tuition Opportunity Programs for Students (TOPS).

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana began a program of providing free tuition for first time qualifying freshmen in Louisiana universities; and

WHEREAS, the program has been a tremendous success; and

WHEREAS, more people are taking advantage of the program which necessitates additional funding; and

WHEREAS, the TOPS program is an excellent opportunity for young Louisiana citizens to obtain a college education, and a tremendous incentive to remain in our state to obtain their education; and

WHEREAS, the TOPS program will also help foster a better Louisiana higher education program, offer more economic opportunities for our citizens, and help raise our educational level which has notoriously been one of the lowest in the country; and

WHEREAS, the TOPS program has offered benefits to more than 22,000 first time freshmen and sophomores statewide; and

The State of Louisiana will accrue multiple benefits from this program in less crime, reduced unemployment and welfare, experience a higher standard of living and quality of life, and other economic advantages.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request the Governor of the State of Louisiana, its local legislative delegation, and the entire Louisiana legislature to fully fund the TOPS program to ensure that all young Louisianans have an opportunity to attend college in the State of Louisiana regardless of their family's financial status, and does further request that funding be set up on an annual basis in the General Fund to ensure the availability of funds for this valuable and worthwhile program.
