9 A resolution of the Slidell City Council reminding Mardi Gras parade
10 attendees that dogs and other animals and reptiles are not permitted within one hundred
11 fifty feet (150') of parade routes.

12 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has had unfortunate experiences with dogs
13 being present during Mardi Gras parades; and


14 WHEREAS, on occasions dogs have bitten adults and children; and

15 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council passed an ordinance prohibiting dogs
16 and other animals and reptiles from being present within one hundred fifty feet (150') of
17 parade routes or the sites of other public events.

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
19 hereby request all Slidell Mardi Gras parade attendees to refrain from bringing their dogs
20 to Slidell Mardi Gras parades.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Police Department is
22 hereby requested to enforce all terms and conditions of the ordinance to ensure the
23 protection of citizens attending parades during this Mardi Gras season.
