RESOLUTION R99-22

A resolution requesting the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury provide the City of Slidell with its pro rata share of revenue derived from a ten year, one mill property tax for the maintenance and operation of an animal shelter.

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury adopted Resolution No. 99-9086 calling and setting a special election for the entirety of St. Tammany Parish for the levying of a ten year, one mill property tax for the maintenance and operation of an animal shelter in St. Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, May 1, 1999, Proposition No. 1 setting forth said property tax millage was approved by the electorate of all St. Tammany Parish residents including residents of the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has its own animal shelter; and

WHEREAS, residents of the City of Slidell shall be paying millage for the purpose of maintaining and operating an animal shelter for St. Tammany Parish.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request its pro rata share of the revenues derived from Proposition No. 1, a ten year, one mill property tax for acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating an animal shelter for the Parish, including necessary equipment and facilities thereof as approved by the electorate of St. Tammany Parish on Saturday, May 1, 1999.
