9 for amendments to the Home Rule Charter regarding term limits for elected officials.

11 WHEREAS, Resolution R99-24 was adopted at the June 8, 1999, Council
12 meeting; and

13 WHEREAS, said Resolution provides for a maximum of three (3) consecutive
14 terms for each elected official in their respective office; and

15 WHEREAS, amendments to the ballot language would make this proposition
16 more descriptive with reference to its effective date.

17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
18 hereby amend Resolution R99-24 as follows:


19 Page 2, line 16, before the word "shall" add the following, "Effective with the term
20 of office beginning July 1, 1990,".

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Exhibit A attached thereto is hereby
22 amended as follows:

23 Under "PROPOSITION," before the word "shall" add "Effective with the term of office
24 beginning July 1, 1990,".

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the City
26 Attorney and Council Administrator are hereby authorized to put the intent of this
27 Resolution in proper form for submission to the State Bond Commission, Secretary of
28 State, and all other necessary offices and agencies .
