8 **RESOLUTION BY THE SLIDELL CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING THE SLIDELL**
9 **MUNICIPAL POLICE EMPLOYEES CIVIL SERVICE BOARD TO CONCUR WITH**
10 **EQUALIZATION OF EMPLOYEE BENEFITS**

12 A resolution of the Slidell City Council seeking the Municipal Police Employees
13 Civil Service Board's concurrence with employee benefit changes unanimously adopted by
14 the Slidell City Council at its meeting of January 12, 1999.

16 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, on January
17 12, 1999, unanimously adopted Ordinance No. 2859 providing for equalization of benefits
18 for all city employees; and

19 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has struggled with the problem of equalization
20 of employee benefits for in excess of approximately twenty (20) years; and

21 WHEREAS, there have been a great amount of research, discussion, time,
22 effort, and hard work over a long period of time, and many meetings; and


23 WHEREAS, a conscientious effort was made to ensure that city employees
24 would not lose any benefits; and

25 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has authorized the buy back of accumulated
26 annual leave at one hundred percent (100%) of the employee's current salary; and

27 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council unanimously requests the Municipal Police
28 Employees Civil Service Board to earnestly consider Ordinance No. 2859 establishing
29 equalization of benefits for all Slidell Civil Service employees.

30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
31 hereby unanimously request the Municipal Police Employees Civil Service Board of the City
32 of Slidell to concur with and approve Ordinance No. 2859 adopted January 12, 1999, by the
33 Slidell City Council equalizing benefits for all Slidell Civil Service employees.
