4 **RESOLUTION NO. 00-07**

5 A resolution of the Slidell City Council named "*Operation Keep Slidell*
6 *Beautiful*" to encourage residents to maintain their property in an orderly and neat
7 fashion, keep grass cut, eliminate junk and inoperable vehicles, with said operation
8 being a cooperative effort between the Slidell City Council, the City Administration,
9 and the Slidell City Court system.

10 WHEREAS, the majority of property owners in the City of Slidell maintain
11 their property in a neat and orderly manner; and

13 WHEREAS, a certain portion of properties within our City are in need of
14 cleaning up; and



16 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council encourages all property owners to
17 eliminate junk, maintain their lawns and generally spruce up the appearance of their
18 property; and

20 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council working with the City Administration
21 and the City Court system will be targeting property owners who violate certain
22 provisions of the City code dealing with matters as described above; and

24 WHEREAS, the City Administration will have a cooperative effort with the
25 City Court system to bring violators before the City Court in a timely and expeditious
26 manner.

28 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
29 does hereby promote operation "*Operation Keep Slidell Beautiful*" and does further
30 request that all citizens of the City maintain their property in a neat and orderly
31 fashion and that said violators of any City codes pertaining to same shall be
32 prosecuted expeditiously by the City Administration working in conjunction with the
33 City Court.
