7 A resolution requesting that the Department of Transportation and
8 Development (DOTD) frequently patrol the area south of the City of Slidell on U. S.
9 Highway 11 for illegally parked vehicles, boats, trailers, and the like, with "For Sale"
10 signs thereon.

11 WHEREAS, the State right-of-way immediately south of the City of Slidell
12 on U. S. Highway 11 is frequently used as an illegal parking lot for vehicles, boats,
13 trailers, and the like, as a "For Sale" site; and

15 WHEREAS, this is an eyesore for the south entrance to the City of Slidell;


19 WHEREAS, this poses a hazard as cars are unable to pull off the road
20 onto the right-of-way, and is potentially dangerous as people are "rubbernecking" as
21 they drive by; and

24 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has adopted a resolution and policy to
25 "Keep Slidell Beautiful" by eliminating junk and obnoxious materials in the City; and

27 WHEREAS, DOTD has occasionally patrolled this area and issued
28 citations.

30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
31 does hereby request DOTD to frequently patrol and issue citations for illegally parked
32 vehicles, boats, trailers, and the like, immediately south of the City of Slidell on U. S.
33 Highway 11.
