RESOLUTION NO. R01-03

A resolution authorizing a judicial building fund for the City Court of Slidell, Wards 8 and 9, of St. Tammany Parish.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 13:1910 authorizes a service charge not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) per filing for a judicial building fund; and

WHEREAS, all money collected in accordance with said provision shall be forwarded to the court and placed in an account dedicated exclusively to the acquisition, leasing, construction, equipping, and maintenance of new and existing courts, and for the maintenance and payment of any bond indebtedness on any such existing facility; and

WHEREAS, the Court shall have control over the fund and all disbursements made from the fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Court of Slideil, Wards 8 and 9, of St. Tammany Parish wishes to create such a fund and impose fees as authorized; and

WHEREAS, approval by the Slidell City Council is required before the fund is established and any fees are imposed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby approve a judicial building fund for the City Court of Slidell, Wards 8 and 9, of St. Tammany Parish, all in accordance with the terms and conditions of Louisiana Revised Statutes13:1910.
