6 A resolution authorizing a judicial building fund for the City Court of Slidell,
7 Wards 8 and 9, of St. Tammany Parish.

9 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 13:1910 authorizes a service
10 charge not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) per filing for a judicial building fund; and
11

12 WHEREAS, all money collected in accordance with said provision shall be
13 forwarded to the court and placed in an account dedicated exclusively to the
14 acquisition, leasing, construction, equipping, and maintenance of new and existing
15 courts, and for the maintenance and payment of any bond indebtedness on any such
16 existing facility; and


19 WHEREAS, the Court shall have control over the fund and all
20 disbursements made from the fund; and

23 WHEREAS, the City Court of Slidell, Wards 8 and 9, of St. Tammany
24 Parish wishes to create such a fund and impose fees as authorized; and

27 WHEREAS, approval by the Slidell City Council is required before the
28 fund is established and any fees are imposed.

30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
31 does hereby approve a judicial building fund for the City Court of Slidell, Wards 8 and
32 9, of St. Tammany Parish, all in accordance with the terms and conditions of Louisiana
33 Revised Statutes 13:1910.
