6 A resolution of the Slidell City Council supporting local collection of taxes.

8 WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Louisiana grants local
9 Governments the right to levy and collect local sales and use taxes; and
10

11 WHEREAS, sales and use tax revenues for the St. Tammany parish
12 Sheriff's Office represent approximately 28% of our total general fund and 98% of our
13 special revenue jail fund; and


15 WHEREAS, local administration and collection of sales and use taxes are
16 the best means to protect our most important revenue source; and

18 WHEREAS, local governments do not wish to be dependent on outside
19 agencies to manage this critical function; and

21 WHEREAS, Senate Bills No. 170, 171 & 193, authored by Senator Michot
22 in the 2001 Regular Session is proposing to have the State of Louisiana collect local
23 sales and use taxes.

25 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
26 does hereby urge and request every member of the St. Tammany Parish Legislative
27 delegation to vigorously support local administration and collection of sales and use
28 taxes.
