6 A resolution to the St. Tammany Parish Government requesting that said
7 Government cease large developments north of the City of Slidell for six (6) months.

8 WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany has grown considerably in the last
9 decade and improvements to the Parish drainage basins would relieve flooding in the
10 incorporated City of Slidell; and


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13 WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish has under consideration several new
14 developments that could further complicate drainage efficiency in the City of Slidell;
15 and
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18 WHEREAS, citizens of the City of Slidell are also residents of St.
19 Tammany Parish and should be provided fair and equal consideration.

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21 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it
22 does hereby request the St. Tammany Parish Government to cease all large
23 developments for six (6) months from Airport Road to I-59 until such time as a
24 comprehensive drainage program is developed and is in place so as to curtail any
25 future flooding in the City limits of Slidell. During this time, drainage studies will be
26 completed and distributed to appropriate governmental entities to solve future
27 drainage problems. Existing projects under consideration are exempt.
