A resolution to the St. Tammany Parish Government requesting that said Government cease large developments north of the City of Slidell for six (6) months.

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany has grown considerably in the last decade and improvements to the Parish drainage basins would relieve flooding in the incorporated City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish has under consideration several new developments that could further complicate drainage efficiency in the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, citizens of the City of Slidell are also residents of St.

Tammany Parish and should be provided fair and equal consideration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby request the St. Tammany Parish Government to cease all large developments for six (6) months from Airport Road to 1-59 until such time as a comprehensive drainage program is developed and is in place so as to curtail any future flooding in the City limits of Slidell. During this time, drainage studies will be completed and distributed to appropriate governmental entities to solve future drainage problems. Existing projects under consideration are exempt.
