RESOLUTION NO. R02-07

A resolution urging the Louisiana Legislature to immediately pass legislation to remove long-term debt from the base of the corporate franchise tax and to eliminate one-half of the state sales tax on the purchase of business machinery and equipment.

WHEREAS, job growth in Louisiana in the last decade was the second lowest in the South; Louisiana lags behind every southern state except Florida and Virginia in the amount of private payrolls that come from manufacturing; median income in the state dropped by \$1,674 from 1998-2000; and in 2000, the per capita personal income was only 78.2% of the national average; and

WHEREAS, between 1999-2000, the increase in annual pay for Louisiana residents was the smallest in the country, and in that same year, the rate of job growth dropped by 50%; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana was the only southern state to experience a net loss in domestic migration during the past 10 years; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana offers few incentives for businesses to locate or expand in the state and the few that are offered, such as the Ten Year Industrial Tax Exemption, are under constant attack; and

WHEREAS, under Louisiana's current tax structure, the state cannot compete effectively with other states to attract business; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is one of the only two states in the entire nation that includes debt in the base of its corporate franchise tax; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is one of only three states in the country – and the only southern state – that does not have an exemption for sales tax on the purchase of machinery and equipment used in production, and it is the only southern state that fully taxes those purchases.

WHEREAS, major legislation will be introduced during the regular legislative session that will eliminate these two disincentives to investment in Louisiana;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does hereby call upon the members of the Louisiana Legislature to immediately pass legislation to remove long-term debt from the base of the corporate franchise tax and to eliminate one-half of the state sales tax on the purchase of business machinery and equipment.
